Dress Rehearsal/ Day of Show

Junior Court are asked to arrive on day of program dressed and ready with hair and makeup done. They can change into production number outfit after arriving. We ask parents to be prompt in picking up their junior court girls following practices, rehearsals, and competition night. We will do our best to stay on schedule. Please make sure your daughters get sufficient rest so they are patient and flexible.

Hair/Makeup

Hair can be worn any style, parents may be able to help backstage to change their styles before evening wear, but we find its best to come already done. Junior Court will receive the production T-shirt, rhinestone headband/tiara, and sash Friday night at dress rehearsal.

After Coronation

Parents are to come to the junior court room to pick up their daughters from chaperones. Prior authorizations need to be discussed if someone else is taking your daughter home.

Food and Drinks

Only water is allowed in the dressing room, auditorium, and carpeted areas in the facility. Junior Court may not bring sticky food or food that could stain in dressing rooms. Water and some snacks will be provided. You should pack a large shirt, robe, or zip up sweatshirt for them to wear while eating.

Performance

Junior Court will learn a dance routine which will be performed on stage on competition night. It is important to make the rehearsals to learn the routine.

Dressing Room

Each junior court member may have one family member backstage to assist them changing. We ask that no men are allowed unless dropping off or picking up. There will be plenty of help to assist if needed.

Lottery

Junior Court members who would like to be placed in our lottery *(as indicated on your application) will have the chance to go to Miss Oregon/Miss Oregon Teen with a title holder and participate in the Junior Court Camp. The number of junior court members drawn will depend upon the numbers of titles awarded (at the discretion of the board). Names will be drawn on competition night on stage. Junior Court member chosen will remain on stage to have pictures taken with new title holders.

Gifts

You may bring flowers and gifts for your junior court member, but no other family members may enter dressing room. They can leave at front office or deliver after you pick them up.

You are also welcome to bring a card for your daughter's candidate competing. We ask if you decide to buy a gift, for it to be a single flower or a small piece of candy or chocolate, keep it minimal.
